Mark W. Brewer, 21,

Southbrook Drive, Greenville, died last night at Wayne Hospital from injuries suffered earlier in a smash-up on State Route 49. (See page 1 of today's Daily Advocate) for complete details of the accident.)

Brewer was enrolled in Anderson College, Anderson, Indiana, where he was a junior specializing in Criminal Justice. He was a graduate of Greenville High School with the class of 1974.

He was active in sports, playing basketball both in high school and college. For the past two summers he has been employed by DeKalb, Greenville.

While attending college he was employed by the Firestone Store in Anderson, Indiana. Brewer had attended the Christian and Missionary Alliance Church, Greenville and during college he attended the Church of God, Anderson.

Survivors include his parents, Emerson and Barbara (Swank) Brewer, 405 Southbrooke Drive, Greenville. Also a brother, Allen Kent Brewer, Naval Academy, Annapolis, Maryland; one sister, Loretta Mae Brewer, at home. Also a paternal grandmother, Erma Mae Brewer, 7119 U.S. 36 east, Greenville; maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Ray Swank, Sr., St. Rt. 502 west, Greenville. He was preceded in death by his grandfather, Noah Brewer in 1972.

Funeral services will be held at the Christian and Missionary Alliance Church at 2 p.m. Friday with the Rev. Forrest L. Plumb, officiating.

Burial will follow in the Ft. Jefferson Cemetery.
